This Week's Focus

Sight Words: review all sight words

Phonics: /p/, /j/

Handwriting: Q, G, S, A

Reading - We are making making pre-reading predictions about what will happen in fiction books. We'll use the title, illustrations on the cover/back of the book, and our schema to support our predictions.

Writing - The students are working on covers for their pattern books. They will also continue coming up with their own patterns for their books. Throughout the week we'll do mini lessons about leaving spaces between our words, making sure our sentences have punctuation, and checking that our sight words are spelled correctly.

Math - We are comparing numbers! We'll look at groups of objects to see which has more or fewer. They'll practice adding one more or taking one away to see how many there are now.

S.S. & Science- The students will create a 3-D version of their favorite place to go in town and bring this in on October 15th. We are starting a unit on weather! It has been nice and cool in the mornings so hopefully, we'll see more changes in the weather as we do observations each day. We'll discuss what a meteorologist does and how they record and observe the weather each day. We'll talk about the different types of clouds and what type of weather comes along with them.
